Over the past years, VAW seminars have attracted international and national speakers from emerging, early career, and experienced researchers based at universities, and those working in the field. This year, we extend that invitation to hearing survivor's stories.

This seminar focuses on intersectional violence. We have presentations on disclosure experiences of asylum-seeking women, Killing of Women in the Name of 'Honour', domestic violence and abuse in lesbian, gay, bisexual and/or transgender relationships: power and difference at the intersections, ssupporting survivors of domestic violence in the travelling community and a personal story of Forced Marriage.

Keynote speakers this year include Professor Catherine Donovan, University of Sunderland; Dr Aisha K. Gill, University of Roehampton and Dr Rebecca Barnes, University of Leicester.
